**1- Mobility to SLOVENIA.**

Due to COVID-19 we agree to postpone this mobility.

**Changes on mobilities (LTT).**

We make the following changes on the dates of next mobilities.

**2- TIME TABLE**

P1 -Establishing the project teams (teachers/students).

First of all, each partner country will establish their project teams at school. I suggest you should distribute the tasks or responsibilities among the project team. On my side, I will do it in that way. We will be sending e-mails and WhatsApp messages in our group. Immediate replies are important for the tasks and activities to be completed on time. As far as I know, some of our partners' schools are closed due to the covid 19. The open ones will also establish a project team consisting of students who will take active roles in the project. The age of them will be from 11 to 14 years old. It seems we will not be able to take students to the mobilities this year. We will see. Turkey will prefer to take students of 12-13 years old. SO, we will consider this while choosing the students. I suggest you should consider it, too in your planning.

P2 –Registering students on TwinSpace. Presentations of students to each other. Research on partners, making collaborative presentations, articles for our magazine.

You know, We registered our project on e-twinning. The teachers and students in the project teams will join e-twinning. Poland will manage etwinning.

Those who have already an e-twinning account add me please. Then, the ones that don't have an account in the project team members create accounts and add me on e-twinning. Next, I will send you invitation to our project.

Registering students in twinspace. Presentations of students to each other. Research on partners, making collaborative presentations, articles for our magazine. Each partner country will do.

P3-(01/2021). Creating dissemination tools: Website and TwinSpace. A website and Erasmus+ link will be created by Slovenia. Each country will create a link in their school's website. It will include the stages, news, the flags, project logo, Erasmus+ logo, the descriptions of the partners and website links. Elaboration of a toolkit of resources (worksheets, evaluation and assessment forms). Making a chain movie. Slovenia, as the coordinator, will buy a domain for the project website. The name of the website can be [www.learnandparticipate.com](http://www.learnandparticipate.com). It is our suggestion. The website will be open.

P4 - Project evaluation: preliminary, during and after the project. In addition, we will evaluate participants before and after mobility. Hungary will be responsible for this task. It will be done online. But, we will not do it for now.

P5- Share your experience: As we haven't done any mobilities yet, we will do it later after we do a mobility. (6 times)

P6 -Informing our community by organizing displays, meetings (4 times). We will inform our community about the project by organizing displays, meetings with the school staff, the students, the parents, the folk and the local press, local authorities, etc. We will do it when the pandemic allows.

P7- Each partner institution will create an Erasmus corner at school. The activities will be displayed. Partner institutions will create an Erasmus corner in their schools. After each mobility, the activities carried out will be displayed in the partners Erasmus+ corners. Each country will do.

P8- Writing a journal with impressions about mobilities. As we haven't done any mobilities yet, we will do it later. The partner institutions will create a journal in their schools. The participants will write a journal with their feelings and impressions about the mobility to the other country and they must share their journals with partners after the mobilities.

P9 -(01/2021) Live Dictionary: Preparing a dictionary by using Web 2.0 tools and uploading it on etwinning. It will consist of daily expressions, be written, auditory and visual, and include partner countries' language and English meanings. **Günlük hayatı kullanılan sözler olacak.**

Spain will be responsible for this task. Spain will prepare a form that can be filled online and each country will **add the words and voice in their** own language. The links or/and products will be uploaded on common platforms.

**P10- Logo competition:** Students and teachers are invited to design a logo and vote online for their favourite one. The coordinator will award the winner. It will be used on products.

#### **The rules how to prepare the logos:**

Students will draw it by hand on A3 sheet (29.7cm x 42 cm) or do it digitally by a computer program.

The name of the student and country will be written at the back of it. It should contain all the partners.

They will vote according to:

**Visuality:** It should be well-designed visually. Words or sentences should be legible. Images should be clear. It should not include any politics.

**Intelligibility:** It should be clear to understand.

**Originality:** It should not be copied from a famous logo.

**Eligibility:** It should not be a picture or a poster.

**Relevance:** It should be about the project.

**Logo Selection Calendar:** After this meeting, each partner will announce the competition in their school. Each school will have chosen their winning logo by the middle of January. And We will send our own winning logo to Hungary by the middle of February (15/02/2021) and the project logo will have been chosen by the middle of March (15/03/2021, Time:00:00). There will be no information about which logo belongs to which country in the online questionnaire. We will share it on common platforms.

#### **3-Next online meeting.**

We arrange the next online meeting for the third or fourth week in January, always after the lessons start in all the countries.

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
