# Turning Torso

The Turning Torso in Malmö, south of Sweden is the tallest building in the Nordic countries (Sweden, Norway, Denmark, Finland and Iceland).

It is 190.4 m tall and is mainly an apartment building/complex.

To catch the view of Malmö on top of the Turning Torso, you have to plan ahead because it is rarely opened to the public.

All of these songs were ranked number 1 in the global official charts. They even won the Eurovision Song Contest in 1974.





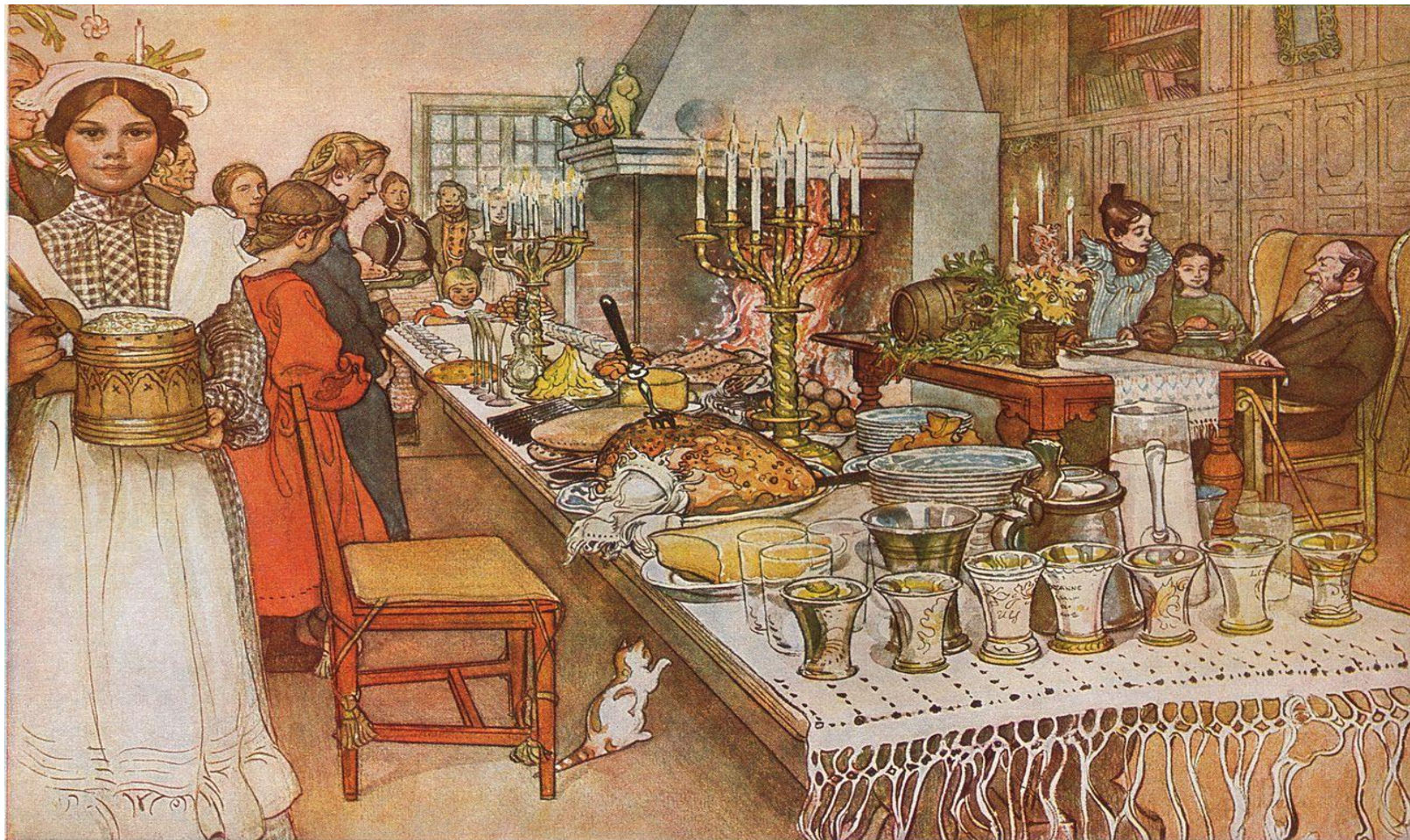
# Midsommar

Christmas Eve 24th December is the biggest holiday celebration in Sweden. It's the day when families, friends and love ones gather to end the calendar year. 25th December that is believed to be the birthday of Jesus Christ isn't a big day in Sweden in that perspective. The watch night 24 December prior to his birth is the main celebration day in Sweden. The whole of Sweden comes to an end from 14.00 on Christmas Eve.
