
Arvo Pärt

He is an Estonian composer of classical and religious music. Since the late 1970s, Pärt has worked in a minimalist style that employs tintinnabuli, a compositional technique he invented

He is an Estonian singer, guitarist, composer and actor. He is one of the most influential and remarkable names in Estonian rock music of the past 40 years.



The Tallinn Song Festival Grounds (Estonian: Lauluväljak) are the grounds on which the Estonian Song Festival is held every five years.



The Tallinn Town Hall

(Estonian: Tallinna raekoda)

It is a building in the Old town of Tallinn. The building is located on the south side of the medieval market square and is 36.8 metres long. The town hall has been on the UNESCO world Heritage Sites list since 1997. In 2004, the Tallinn Town Hall celebrated its 600th birthday.




A Blood Sausage

(in Estonian: Verivorst)

It is a sausage filled with blood that is cooked or dried and mixed with a filler. Most commonly, the blood of pigs, sheep, lamb, cow, chicken, or goose is used.



Kama is a traditional Estonian finely milled flour mixture. The kama powder is a mixture of roasted barley, rye, oat and pea flour. It is mostly enjoyed for breakfast mixed with milk, buttermilk or kefir. It is frequently sweetened with sugar and especially with blueberry, more rarely with other fruits or honey or served unsweetened.



Irina Embrich

She is a famous Estonian left-handed épée fencer. Embrich is a two-time team European champion and 2017 team world champion.

A two-time Olympian, Embrich is a 2021 team Olympic champion.



Kelly Sildaru

She is a famous Estonian freestyle skier. She became the youngest gold medalist at a Winter X Games event, and the first person to win a Winter X Games medal for Estonia. She is also the youngest to win two X Games gold medals.



The Baltic song festival

Is a traditional amateur song festival in the Baltic states included in the UNESCO Intangible Cultural Heritage List.



The dance festival
